NOTIFICATION

Dated, the 5th January, 2022

No.1/51/83-MHS/DP(III) : In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India and other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Manipur is pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Manipur Health Service Rules, 1982, namely :-

1. Short title and commencement :

- 1) These rules may be called the Manipur Health Service (3rd Amendment) Rules, 2021
- 2) These rules shall come into force from the date of notification in the State Gazette.

2. (a) The existing Rule 7(3)(b) to the Manipur Health Service Rules, 1982 shall be substituted by the following :-

“Rule 7(3)(b): 100% of the Non-Specialist Post in MHS Gr. III shall be filled by promotion from amongst MHS Gr. IV Officers with 5 years regular service in the grade. 75% of the Specialist posts in MHS Grade III shall be filled by promotion from MHS Gr. IV officers with 3 years regular service in the grade after possessing PG Degree (three years course) or MHS Gr. IV officers with 4 years regular service in the grade after possessing PG Diploma (two Years course) or MHS Gr. IV officers with 5 years regular service in the grade after possessing PG Diploma (one year course). 25% of the Specialist posts shall be filled by direct recruitment.

Provided that so far as promotion to any Specialist post is concerned only such officers possessing PG qualifications appropriate to the post from amongst the PG qualifications prescribed in Part A, B & C of Annexure to Schedule II shall be eligible”.

(b) The existing Rule 7(3)(c) to the Manipur Health Service Rules, 1982 shall be substituted by the following :-

“Rule 7(3)(c): 100% of the Non-Specialist Post in MHS Gr. II shall be filled by promotion from amongst MHS Gr. III Officers with 5 years regular service in the grade. 100% of the Sr. Specialist posts in MHS Grade II shall be filled by promotion from MHS Gr. III officers with 3 years regular service in the grade after possessing PG Degree (three years course) or MHS Gr. III officers with 4 years regular service in the grade after possessing PG Diploma (two Years course) or MHS Gr. III officers with 5 years regular service in the grade after possessing PG Diploma (one year course).

Provided that so far as promotion to any Specialist post is concerned only such officers possessing PG qualifications appropriate to the post from amongst the PG qualifications prescribed in Part A,B&C of Annexure to.Schedule II shall be eligible”.

(c) The existing Annexure to Schedule II to the Manipur Health Service Rules (Post Graduate Qualifications) shall be substituted with the following:-
