## **ORDERS BY THE GOVERNOR: MANIPUR**

Imphal, the 5<sup>th</sup> September, 2024

No. MED-1202/2/2024-HS-HEALTH: In exercise of the powers conferred under Section 46 clause (f) and (ff) of the Pharmacy Act, 1948, the Governor of Manipur is pleased to include the following Rules in the Manipur State Pharmacy Council Rules, 2003 regarding qualifications of the Pharmacy Inspectors (PI) and Office Assistant (OA) to implement Section 42 of the Pharmacy Act, 1948, as directed by Pharmacy Council of India:

"Rule No. 106 (a) The minimum qualification of the Pharmacy Inspector to be appointed by the Manipur State Pharmacy Council shall be "a registered pharmacist possessing Degree in Pharmacy or Diploma in Pharmacy with Bachelors Degree in any discipline.

Experience: 5 (five) years experience for Degree in Pharmacy / 7 (seven) years experience for Pharmacy Diploma holders with Bachelors Degree in any discipline presently working in the Government/Public Sector /Private Sector Undertakings".

"Rule No. 106 (b) For Office Assistant to be appointed by the Manipur State Pharmacy Council, the minimum qualification shall be as per the existing R.R. of the Government of Manipur and desirable qualifications (i) Diploma in Pharmacy or Bachelor of Pharmacy (ii) Diploma in Computer Application".

2. These rules shall come into force from the date of publication in the Extraordinary Gazette.
