NOTIFICATION

Imphal, the 21st July, 2023

No. RRDP-37/4/2023-DP-DP(i) : In exercise of the powers conferred by the Proviso to clause (3) of Article 320 of the Constitution of India read with the decision of the State Cabinet in its sitting held on 04.01.2022, the Governor of Manipur is hereby makes the following regulation to further amend the Manipur Public Service Commission (Exemption from Consultation) Regulations, 1972 namely:

1. SHORT TITLE AND COMMENCEMENT:
2. These regulations may be called the Manipur Public Service Commission (Exemption from consultation) (Amendment) Regulations, 2023
3. They shall come into force from the date of issue of Notification.
4. Addition of Regulation 121 - After Regulation 120 of the Manipur Public Service Commission (Exemption from Consultation) Regulations, 1972, the following regulation shall be added, namely:

" 121 it shall not be necessary to consult the Commission in regard to filling up of vacant post of Executive Engineer in RED/MSRRDA on promotion with one time relaxation of the requirement years of service as Assistant Engineer (Civil/ Mech) for promotion to Executive Engineer (Civil/ Mech) occurring in column 11 of MPSC Form 8 of the Recruitment Rules for the post of Executive Engineer (Planning)/Surveyor of Works(Civil); Executive Engineer(Civil); SW(Executive Engineer-Plg/Admn) and SW/ Executive Engineer in the Rural Engineering Department, Manipur vide Notification No. 1/16/21-RR(RED)/DP dated 28th September, 2022 as:
