NOTIFICATION

Imphal, the 7th April, 2022

No. RRDP-44/1/2020-DP-DP: In supersession of all previous rules issued in exercise of the powers conferred by the Proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Manipur hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of **District Transport Officer** in Transport Department, Government of Manipur as shown in the M.P.S.C. Form-8, namely:-

1. **Short title:-** These rules may be called Transport Department, Government of Manipur **District Transport Officer** Recruitment Rules, 2022.
2. **Application:-** These rules shall apply to the post specified in column 1 of the M.P.S.C. Form-8 hereto annexed.
3. **Classification, Scale of pay, method of recruitment etc.:-** Classification of the said post, scale of pay, method of recruitment and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in the columns 3 to 13 of the said MPSC Form-8.
4. **Disqualification:-**
 - (a) No person, who has more than one wife living or who having a spouse living, marries in any case in which such marriage is void by reason of its taking place during the life time of such spouse, shall be eligible for appointment to the aforesaid post, and
 - (b) No woman, whose marriage is void by reason of the husband having a wife living at the time of such marriage or who has married a person who has a wife living at the time of such marriage, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Governor of Manipur may, if satisfied that there are special grounds for so ordering, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. "Power to relax- Where the Governor is of opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may order for reasons to be recorded in writing, and in consultation with the Manipur Public Service Commission, for relaxation of any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons or posts."
6. These rules shall come into force with effect from the date of publication in the Manipur Gazette.

**RECRUITMENT RULES FOR THE POST OF DISTRICT TRANSPORT OFFICER
(DTO) IN THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORT, MANIPUR**

1.	Designation of Post(s)	District Transport Officer
2.	No. of Post(s)	12 (Twelve)
3.	Classification	GCS Group-B (Gazetted/Non-ministerial)
4.	Scale of pay	Rs. 9,300-34,800+Grade Pay Rs. 4,300/- [As prescribed in MS (RP), Rules, 2019].
5.	Whether selection post or non-selection post	Selection
6.	Age for direct recruits	Minimum : 18 years Maximum : 38 years (Upper age limit is relaxable for Govt. servants appointed under the Government of Manipur to the extent of the period of continuous services put in the post/service and by 5 years for SC/ST candidates and by 3 years for OBC candidates and a Government servant who belongs to SC/ST will get the facility admissible to a Government servant in addition to the relaxation admissible to SC/ST candidates) . Relaxation of age shall be applicable to the candidates as per Government Orders/O., etc issued from time to time).
7.	Educational and other qualifications required for direct recruits.	ESSENTIAL: Degree or equivalent in Mechanical Engineering from a recognised University/Institute. OR B. Tech. (Computer Science/Electronics & Communication/IT)/M.Sc. (IT) from a recognised University/Institute.
8.	Whether age and educational qualification prescribed for the direct recruits will apply in the case of promotees.	N.A.
9.	Period of probation, if any	2 (two) years
10.	Method of recruitment whether by direct recruitment or by promotion or by deputation/transfer & percentage of the total sanctioned post to be filled by various method.	50% by Promotion and 50% by direct recruitment

11.	In case of recruitment by promotion/deputation/transfer, grades from which promotion/deputation/transfer to be made.	PROMOTION: Inspectors of MV Deptt. with 5 (five) years regular service in the grade who have completed Graduation from a recognised University with experience in Driving vehicles, failing which, Inspectors who have completed a regular service of 20 years in the combined grade of Inspectors and Sub-Inspectors with at least 2 years of regular service as Inspector and who has completed Graduation from a recognised University with experience in driving vehicles.
12.	If a DPC exists, what is its composition.	Class-II D.P.C.
13.	Circumstances in which MPSC is to be consulted in making recruitment	MPSC is to be consulted in making recruitment OR As required under Manipur Public Service Commission (Exemption from Consultation) Regulations, 1972.
