No. PLC-101/1/2022-DITC-DIT: Whereas, Information Technology sector in the State and other neighbouring States has undergone the natural processes of change – some radical, some incremental so much so that the citizen's expectations in terms of deliverables from a systems environment has expanded many folds, since the issue of the 'Manipur Information Technology Policy 2015';

2. Whereas, towards ensuring the success of the IT Industry in Manipur and the development of the IT SEZ, a progressive business-friendly policy and State of the Art Infrastructure is required in the area. The Government has been cognizant of this and in line with the same the Manipur IT Policy and the Imphal ITSEZ has been envisaged.

3. Whereas, it is considered necessary to replace the abovementioned policy of 2015 by a new one to develop the IT and ITES Sector in the State. The policy is focused on bringing investments in the State, creating Job Opportunities, empowering the youth and women, etc. bringing the desired development in the State.

4. Now, the Governor of Manipur is pleased to formulate and adopt an Information Technology policy namely, "Manipur Information Technology Policy 2022" as per annexure to the notification.

5. The Manipur Information Technology Policy, 2022 shall come into force with effect from 10<sup>th</sup> May, 2022. The "Manipur Information Technology Policy, 2015" stands withdrawn with effect from 10<sup>th</sup> May, 2022.
