NoPS1-704/4/2022-EDN(S)-EDN(S): Whereas, the Government of Manipur announced 100 Action Points for First 100 Days in March, 2022 and as one of the Action Points, a Scheme for distribution of Free laptops to all meritorious students passing Class 12 is to be formulated;

Whereas, the State Cabinet has approved the Chief Minister's Meritorious Students E-Support Scheme for distribution of Free laptops to all meritorious students passing Class 12 in its sitting held on 21.04.2022;

And whereas, Finance Department (PIC), Government of Manipur has allotted U.O. No. 80/2022-2023/FD(PIC) dated 23.05.2022 to the formulation of Chief Minister's Meritorious Students E-Support Scheme (CMMSESS) under 100 Action points for first 100 Days Programme;

Now, therefore, the Governor of Manipur hereby formulates and notifies 'the Chief Minister's Meritorious Students E-Support Scheme (CMMSESS)' as Annexed.

Annexure-I

GUIDELINES FOR CHIEF MINISTER'S MERITORIOUS STUDENTS E-SUPPORT SCHEME (CMMSESS)

1. Title: These guidelines may be called Chief Minister's Meritorious Students E-Support Scheme (CMMSESS)

2. Background:

The Government of Manipur announced 100 Action Points for First 100 Days in March, 2022. As one of the Action Points, a Scheme for distribution of Free laptops to all meritorious students passing Class 12 is to be formulated;

3. Objective:

The main objective of this scheme is to give free laptops to meritorious students passing Class 12 in order to help the students in their higher studies. In this era of Information Technology, the possession of a machine to tap into the vast depository of information has become a basic necessity for the students, to keep oneself in tune with the changing pace of the world. Moreover, emergence of blended learning as the new face of the 21st Century Education and the focus of the new National Education Policy 2020 in enhancing blended learning has all the more made it imperative for the students to possess a smart phone/ tablet/ laptop/ desktop system. The scheme aims to augment the need of the students to a certain extent.

4. Target Group:

Meritorious students of Government and Government Aided Schools of the State passing Class 12 Examination (COHSEM).

5. SCOPE:

The number of students to be selected for each District will be calculated based on the number of Class 12 appearing students for each District, out of a total of 1000 seats. Seats will also be assigned per stream based on the students appearing per stream (Science, Arts, Commerce) for each district.

6. Eligibility Criteria:

- The applicant must be a permanent resident of Manipur.
- The applicant should have appeared in the Class 12 examination conducted by Council of Higher Secondary Education, Manipur (CoHSEM) from a Government or Government Aided School.
- Minimum percentage to be scored by the students in Class 12 Examination conducted by Council of Higher Secondary Education, Manipur to be eligible for applying under the said scheme is:
 - Science: 75%
 - Arts: 65%
 - Commerce: 65%
- The student should have enrolled in a course of higher studies.

7. Mode of Application:

District-wise merit list of students for the 16 Districts will be obtained from the Council of Higher Secondary Education, Manipur and selections will be made based on that merit list. The Department of Education-Schools will publish the list of eligible students under the

Scheme every year and will invite the selected students to apply through the concerned Zonal Education Officers (ZEOs) under which jurisdiction their school falls, along with the required documents listed below, within a specified dateline.

8. Documents Required:

- PRC issued by competent authority.
- Proof of enrolment in a course of higher studies.
- Copy of Admit Card of appearing in HSE of the relevant year.
- Fully filled in application form which can be downloaded from Department website manipureducation.gov.in.

9. Selection Procedure:

- A Screening Committee to be chaired by the Director, Education-S, Manipur shall screen and shortlist the eligible applicants.
- The shortlisted list of students shall be submitted to the Government for final approval.
- Decision of the Government will be final and binding

10. Financial Implications:

The estimated financial requirement for providing free laptop to 1000 students

Number of students	Per piece Approx. cost of a laptop (Rs. In Lakhs)	Budget (Rs. in Lakhs)
1000	0.60	600

- The number of laptops to be distributed may be increased or decreased by the Government.

11. Formula for calculation of seats per district and per stream:

The allocation of seats out of the 1000 seats per stream and per district will be based on the number of students appearing in the Higher Secondary Examination taken by the COHSEM from the schools under the district in the manner illustrated below:

The number allotted to a district will be as per the formula

$$N = \frac{X}{Y} \times 1000$$

N: No. of seats allotted for the district

X: No. of Govt. School students appearing from schools in the district

Y: Total number of Govt. School students appearing in the state

Out of the total seats allotted for each District, seats assigned for each stream will be calculated as per the formula

$$NS = \frac{S}{X} \times N$$

NS: No. of seats for a stream

S: No. of Govt. school students appearing in the stream from schools in the district.

Further, in case the number of Govt. school students appearing in the HSE conducted by the COHSEM is less than 50, the students of the district will be grouped with the nearest district and seat allocations will be made together for such districts.

Illustration:

The number of Govt. School students appearing in the HSE 2022 conducted by the COHSEM, as per data maintained by the COHSEM is :
