### OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Imphal, the 2nd July, 2012

Subject :- Payment of Dearness Allowance/Dearness Relief to the serving/retired Manipur Judicial Service Officers—Revised rate effective from 01-07-2011.

No. 17/1/2010-FD(PIC).— In continuation of this Government Office Memorandum of even number, dated 16-4-2011, the Governor of Manipur is pleased to enhance the Dearness Allowance/Dearness Relief payable to the serving/retired Manipur Judicial Service Officers from the existing rate of 51% to 58% of Pay/Pension with effect from 01-07-2011.

2. The term 'pay' for the purpose of calculation of Dearness Allowance shall be the pay drawn in the prescribed scale of pay including stagnation increment(s) but shall not include any other type(s) of pay like special pay or personal pay etc.
3. The Dearness Allowance will continue to be a distinct element of remuneration and will not be treated as pay within the ambit of FR 9(21).
4. The payment on account of Dearness Allowance/Dearness Relief involving fractions of 50 paise and above may be rounded off to the next higher rupee and the fractions of less than 50 paise may be ignored.
5. These orders relating to grant of Dearness Relief shall apply to all Pensioners/Family Pensioners of Manipur Judicial Service but shall not be applicable to the Old Age Pension, Political Pension or any other kinds of similar pensions which are not related to the service rendered under the Government of Manipur.
6. The Dearness Relief at the rate indicated above will also be admissible on the additional basic pension/additional family pension available to older pensioners/family pensioners based on their age.
7. Other provisions governing grant of Dearness Relief in respect of employed family pensioners and re-employed State Government pensioners and those relating to regulation of Dearness Relief where pensioners are in receipt of more than one pension will remain unchanged.



8. It will be responsibility of the Pension Disbursing Authority including the Nationalized Banks etc. to calculate the quantum of Dearness Relief payable in each case and the Accountant General (A & E), Manipur and the Authorized Public Sector Banks shall arrange payment of relief to pensioners etc. on the basis of the above instructions.
