### THE MANIPUR APPROPRIATION (No. 3) BILL, 2012

(As introduced in the Manipur Legislative Assembly)

#### Α

#### BILL

to authorize payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Manipur for the services of the Finacial year 2012-13.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Manipur in the sixty-third Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

1. This Act may be called the Manipur Appropriation (No. 3) Act, 2012.

Short Title

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Manipur there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column 3 of the Scheduled amounting in the aggregate to the sum of eight thousand four hundred thirty four crores, sixty three lakhs and seventy one thousand rupees towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year 2012-13 in respect of the services specified in column 2 of the Schedule.

Issue of Rupees 8434,63,71,000 from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Manipur for the Financial year 2012-13

3. The sum authorized to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Manipur by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.

4. References to Departments in the Schedule are to such Departments as existing immediately before the 1st day of March, 2012 and shall, on or after that date the construed as references to the appropriate Departments as reconstitued from time to time.

# MEMORANDUM SHOWING FINANCIAL IMPLICATION OF THE MANIPUR APPROPRIATION (No. 3) BILL, 2012

The Manipur Appropriation (No. 3) Bill, 2012 makes provisions for appropriation of a sum of Rs. 8434,63,71,000/- from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Manipur for the year 2012-13. The various services and purposes for which the amount is sought to be appropriated have been shown in the Schedule to the Bill. Out of the amount, a sum of Rs. 604,28,55,000/- represents the expenditure charged on the Consolidated Fund and the balance of Rs. 7830,35,16,000/- voted by the Legislative Assembly.
