NOTIFICATION

Imphal, the 22nd June, 2009

No. 1/46/94-RR/DP(Pt-I): In supersession of all previous rules issued in this regard and in exercise of the powers conferred by the Proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Manipur hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Graduate Teacher of Government Deaf & Mute School in Social Welfare Department, Manipur as shown in the M.P.S.C. Form-8, namely :-

- Short title :-** These rules may be called the Department of Social Welfare, Manipur **GRADUATE TEACHER** of Government Deaf & Mute School Recruitment Rules, 2009.
- Application :-** These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column 1 of the M.P.S.C. Form-8 hereto annexed.
- Classification, Scale of pay, method of recruitment etc. :-** Classification of the said post, scale of pay, method of recruitment and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in the columns 3 to 13 of the said MPSC Form-8.
- Disqualifications :-**
 - No person, who has more than one wife living or who having a spouse living, marries in any case in which such marriage is void by reason of its taking place during the life time of such spouse, shall be eligible for appointment to the aforesaid post, and
 - No woman, whose marriage is void by reason of the husband having a wife living at the time of such marriage or who has married a person who has a wife living at the time of such marriage, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.Provided that the Governor of Manipur may, if satisfied that there are special grounds for so ordering, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.
- “Power to relax - Where the Governor is of opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Department of Personnel & Administrative Reforms(Personnel Division), for relaxation of any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons or posts.”
- These rules shall come into force with effect from the date of publication in the Manipur Gazette.

RECRUITMENT RULES FOR THE POST OF GRADUATE TEACHER OF GOVERNMENT DEAF & MUTE SCHOOL IN THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WELFARE, MANIPUR.

3.	Classification:	G.C.S. Gr. B (Non-gazetted)
4.	Scale of pay:	Rs. 5,500-175-9,000/- p.m.
5.	Whether selection or non selection post:	Selection

Age for direct recruits:	35(thirtyfive) years & below (upper age limit is relaxable for Govt. servants appointed under the Govt. of Manipur to the extent of the period of continuous services put in the post/service and by 5 years for SC/ST and by 3 years for OBC candidates. Further, a Govt. servant who belongs to SC/ST/OBC will get the facility admissible to a Govt. servant in addition to the relaxation admissible to SC/ST/OBC candidates.)
7.	Educational and other qualification required for direct recruits:	<u>ESSENTIAL:</u> 1. Graduate of a recognised University with B.Ed. 2. Degree/ Diploma in Special Education Hearing Impaired from a recognised University/ Institute. <u>DESIRABLE:</u> 1. Honours in any stream with 55% marks in aggregate at the graduate. 2. Not less than 60% in aggregate in the Diploma in Special Education Hearing Impaired. 3. At least one year teaching experience. 4. A registered member of Rehabilitation Council of India under RCI Act, 1992. 5. Knowledge of Manipuri and Hindi.
8.	Whether age & educational qualification prescribed for direct recruits will apply in the case of promotees:	N.A.
9.	Period of probation, if any:	2(two) years
10.	Method of recruitment whether by direct recruit or by promotion or by deputation/ transfer and percentage of the vacancies to be filled by various methods:	50% by promotion 50% by direct recruitment
