NOTIFICATION Imphal, the 1st April, 2011

No.9/2/09-M(MBBS/BDS) : The Governor of Manipur is pleased to make the following Rules further to amend the MBBS/BDS Entrance Examination (Selection of Candidates for Nomination) Rules, 2004, namely,-

THE MANIPUR MBBS/BDS ENTRANCE EXAMINATION (SELECTION OF CANDIDATES FOR NOMINATION) AMENDMENT RULES, 2011

1. Short title and commencement – (1) These Rules may be called the MBBS/ BDS Entrance Examination (Selection of Candidates for Nomination) Amendment Rules, 2011.

(2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the official gazette.

2. Amendment of Rule 2(f)

For the existing Rule 2(f), the following shall be substituted, namely,-

(f) “Meritorious Sportsperson” means a candidate who had represented the State of Manipur as competitor in the National Sports Championship of Sub-Junior Cadet, Junior cadet, Junior and Senior Level conducted under the auspices of the National Sports Federations recognized by the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Government of India or All India School Championship under the auspices of the School Games Federation of India or who had represented India as a competitor at the International Sports Championship as selected/deputed by the concerned National Sports Federation recognized by the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Govt. of India only for the Sports disciplines mentioned in Annexure-IV.”

3. Amendment of Rule 11.

For the existing Rule 11, the following shall be substituted, namely,-

“Application Form:- Application in a prescribed form for the Competitive Test as given in Annexure -1 shall be issued on payment of Rs. 200/- (Rupees two hundred) only from the office of the Director of Health Services, Manipur”.

4. Amendment of Rule 12.

For the existing Rule 12, the following shall be substituted, namely,-

“Fee for Competitive Test :- The examination fee for the Competitive Test shall be Rs. 600/- (Rupees six hundred) only and Rs. 300/- (Rupees three hundred) only for General/OBC and ST/SC candidates respectively.

5. Amendment of Rule 16

(i) In Rule 16, the words “Award of Marks to meritorious sportspersons and its clauses (i), (ii)(a)(b) & (iii)” shall be deleted and the following shall be substituted, namely,-

“ List of Games/Sports which qualify for Meritorious Sportsperson’s quota for nomination for MBBS/BDS course are indicated in Annx. IV to the Rule”

(ii) For the existing Annexure – IV to Rule 16, the following shall be substituted, namely, -

6. Amendment of Rule 17

For the existing clause (1) of Rule 17, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

“(1) The Selection Board shall prepare the Select List and the Waiting List of candidates, strictly in order of merit, who have obtained not less than 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology taken together in the Competitive Test. In respect of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes, the marks obtained in Physics, Chemistry and Biology taken together in the Competitive Test shall be 40%. And in respect of candidates belonging to Locomotory Disorder/Disability of Lower Limb between 50% to 70%, the marks obtained in Physics, Chemistry and Biology taken together in the Competitive Test shall be 45%”.

7. Amendment of Rule 19

(1) For the existing clause (ii) of Rule 19, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

“(ii) The Government shall reserve **two** MBBS or BDS seats for the Children of Armed Forces Personnel/Ex-servicemen for nomination against the seat as opted by the selected candidates who would be placed in the appropriate categories – General, Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes (excluding the creamy layer of the Backward Classes as defined vide Government of Manipur, Department of Personnel’s letter No.9/1/90(OBC)/DP dated 02.08.2004 read with GOI:DP & TRG’s O.M. No. 36033/3/2004-Estt(Res) dated 09-03-2004) by making adjustment within the quotas available for each category.

(2) For the existing clause (iii) of Rule 19, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

“(iii) The Government shall reserve **two** MBBS or BDS seats for the Meritorious Sports person for nomination against the seat as opted by the selected candidates who would be placed in the appropriate categories – General, Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes (excluding the creamy layer of the Backward Classes as defined vide Government of Manipur, Department of Personnel’s letter No.9/1/90(OBC)/DP dated 02.08.2004 read with GOI:DP & TRG’s O.M. No. 36033/3/2004-Estt(Res) dated 09-03-2004) by making adjustment within the quotas available for each category.
