ORDERS Imphal, the 18th August, 2010

No.38/21/91-R(Pt): Whereas, the erstwhile Collector, Land Acquisition, Imphal with the proposal of the Director, Commerce & Industries, Manipur, requested Revenue Department, Government of Manipur to cause necessary notifications under the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 for acquisition of 4.39 acres of land of Ingkhol class covered by C.S Dag No.1226,1227,1228 and 1229 of Village No.20-Nilakuthi for protection of Boiler Foundation of the Vanaspati and Allied Industries Ltd. at Nilakuthi;

- 2. And whereas, the land acquisition process had already been completed along with the fixation of market value of land;
- 3. And whereas, the Collector, Land Acquisition, Imphal had issued/announced award orders amounting to Rs.5,10,170/- for payment to the affected pattadars;
- 4 .And whereas, the Collector could not make payment due to non-deposit of the required amount by Commerce & Industries Department;
- 5. And whereas, the Commerce and Industries Department, Manipur had also informed that the land in question is not required since the Manipur Vanaspati & Allied Industries Ltd. is lying closed from 1993 and there is no chance of revival;
- 6. And whereas, the Collector(Land Acquisition),Imphal West as per the request of the claimants/D.H.of Original Suit (Land Acquisition) Case No. 13 of 1993 namely R.K Swarnajit Singh and 10 others, submitted a proposal to relinquish the land covered by C.S Dag No. 1226 & 1227 from the aforesaid acquisition;
- 7. And whereas, the above mentioned pattadars have given an Affidavit/Undertaking to the State Government that in case the aforesaid land is relinquished by the authorities they have no further claim under section 48(2) of Land Acquisition Act, 1894;
- 8. Now, therefore, the Governor of Manipur is pleased to withdraw the whole proceedings of acquisition already taken up by the Government, under section 48(1) of the Land Acquisition Act,1894 subject to the conditions that the pattadars will not be paid any damage compensation under section 48(2) of the said Act.
