THE MANIPUR APPROPRIATION (NO. 1) BILL, 2013

(As introduced in the Legislative Assembly, Manipur)

BILL

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Manipur for the services of the financial year, 2012-13.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Manipur in the Sixty fourth year of the Republic of India as follows:-

1. This Act may be called the Manipur Appropriation (No. 1) Act, 2013.

Short Title

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Manipur there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column 3 of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of five hundred eighty crores fifteen lakhs forty five thousand rupees towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year 2012-13 of the services specified in column 2 of the Schedule.

Issue of Rupees 580,15,45,000 from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Manipur for the financial year 2012-13

3. The sum authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Manipur by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.

1. This Act may be called the Manipur Appropriation (No. 1) Act, 2013.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Manipur there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column 3 of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of three thousand two crores ninetyeight lakhs fiftysix thousand rupees towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year 2013-14 in respect of the services specified in column 2 of the Schedule.
