No. TA/23/2025-e-TA & H: Whereas, the Government vide order No. 9/42/92-CHA (pt) A dated 11th April, 2001 declared Shri Lunngjinmei Pamei alias Majabut Pamei as the Khullakpa cum Ex-Officio Chairman of Thangal village.

- 2. Whereas, the Village Authority election result of Thangal Village, Longmai Sub-Division, Noney District was declared vide Notification No. 9/11/2018-Hills (VA) dated 29th June 2019, at Sl. No. 3, wherein Shri Majabut Pamei was notified as Chalrman of the village.
- 3. Whereas, Shri Majabut Pamei filed the W. P (C) No. 206 of 2025 praying for correcting the nomenclature given in the Notification dated 29.06.2019 at Serial No. 3 with respect to Thangal village as Shri Majabut Pamei, Ex-Officio Chairman.
- 4. Whereas, the Hon'ble High Court vide order dated 13.03.2025 disposed of the Writ petition by directing the Respondent No. 1 (i.e Additional Chief Secretary, Government of Manipur) to dispose the Representation dated 30.05.2023 by issuing a speaking order as per the law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of the copy of order.
- 5. Whereas, as per Section 3(4) of the Manipur (Village Authorities in Hill Areas) Act, 1956; "Where there is a Chief or Khullakpa in a village, he shall be the Ex-Officio Chairman of the Village Authority of that village; and where there is no such Chief or Khullakpa in the village, the Chairman of the village Authority of that village shall be elected by the members of the Village Authority from among themselves".

- 6. Whereas, due to typographical error, the nomenclature "Chairman" has been inserted in the Notification No. 9/11/2018- Hills (VA) dated 29th June 2019, at Sl. No. 3, Thangal village in place of Ex-Officio Chairman.
 - 7. Now, in compliance of the Hon'ble High Court order dated 13.03.2025 passed in W. P (C) No. 206 of 2025 and in exercise of power conferred under Section 3 (4) of the Manipur (Village Authorities in Hill Areas) Act 1956, the Governor of Manipur is pleased to modify/amend the Notification dated 29.06.2019 at Serial No. 3 with respect to Thangal village; as Shri Majabut Pamei, Chief/Ex-Officio Chairman.

No. GIA-2/1/2022-MA-MA: The Governor of Manipur is pleased to set up Project Management Units (PMUs) at the level of State Minority Department as well as Waqf Board, Manipur, for effective functioning of the Unified Waqf Management, Empowerment, Efficiency and Development (UMEED) Central Portal to facilitate the management and administration of Waqf properties, and the uploading of their details on the portal, comprising of the following members:

- PMU at the State Level:
 - (i) Director, Minority Affairs, Manipur
 - (ii) An NIC official to be nominated by SIO (NIC), Manipur
 - (iii) A revenue official to be nominated by Secretary(Revenue), Govt. of Manipur
 - (iv) Chief Executive Officer, Waqf Board, Manipur
 - II) PMU at Waqf Board, Manipur:
 - (i) Chief Executive Officer, Waqf Board, Manipur
 - (ii) An NIC official to be nominated by SIO (NIC), Manipur
 - (iii) A revenue official to be nominated by Secretary (Revenue), Govt. of Manipur
 - (iv) Two officials to be nominated by the Chief Executive Officer, Waqf Board, Manipur
- The PMU at the State level shall be housed in the office of the Minority Welfare Department and PMU of Waqf Board shall be housed in the office of the State Waqf Board.
- 3. All PMU officials must be thoroughly trained in their roles and responsibilities and be well-versed in the UMEED Act, 1995 and its Rules to ensure accurate and reliable data entry. The PMUs must be operational by 01 July, 2025.
- 4. Further, CEO/ Waqf Board, Manipur is nominated as the overall State Nodal Officer Manipur, being the key functionary, to ensure effective functioning of the UMEED Central Portal, facilitate the management and administration of Waqf properties, and the uploading of their details on the portal within six months.
