NOTIFICATION

No.100/MR-LA/1/2014: - WHEREAS, the seat of Shri Maibam Kunjo in the Legislative Assembly of the State of Manipur, elected from 38-Hiyanglam Assembly Constituency, has become vacant on 11-08-2014, by reason of his death;

2. WHEREAS, a bye-election is to be held for the purpose of filling the vacancy so caused;

3. **NOW, THEREFORE**, in pursuance of sub-section (1) of section 150, and sections 30 and 56 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 (43 of 1951), the Election Commission of India hereby-

- (A) **Calls upon** the said 38-Hiyanglam Assembly Constituency in the State of Manipur, to elect, before the **22nd October, 2014 (Wednesday)** and in accordance with the provisions of the said Act and of the rules and orders made thereunder, a person for the purpose of filling the said vacancy in the Legislative Assembly of the State;
- (B) **appoints**, with respect to the said election,-
- (a) the 27th September, 2014 (Saturday), as the last date for making nominations;
 - (b) the 29th September, 2014 (Monday), as the date for the scrutiny of nominations,
 - (c) the 1st October, 2014 (Wednesday), as the last date for the withdrawal of candidatures;
 - (d) the 17th October, 2014 (Friday), as the date on which a poll shall, if necessary, be taken; and
 - (e) the 22nd October, 2014 (Wednesday), as the date before which the election shall be completed; and
- (C) **fixes the hours** from **07.00 AM to 4.00 PM**, as the hours during which the poll shall, if necessary, be taken on the date specified above, for the election.
