#### ORDERS BY THE GOVERNOR : MANIPUR

Imphal, the 27<sup>th</sup> March, 2025

**No. H-2002/5/2025-HD-HD:** The Governor of Manipur is pleased to constitute the Committees, consisting of the following officers for consideration of exemption for using the tinted glass/black films on safety glass of vehicles in consequential to the direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court vide judgment dated 27-04-2012 passed in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 265 of 2011 (Avishek Goenka vs. Union of India & Anr.) as below:

2. Terms of Reference of the Screening Committee:
- The Screening Committee shall consider such cases for grant of exemption for using tinted glass/black films on safety glass of vehicles and shall made recommendation after duly examine the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India Judgment dated 27-04-2012 passed in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 265 of 2011 (Avishek Goenka vs. Union of India & Anr.);
  - The Screening Committee shall consider only the cases of the persons who have been provided with Z and Z+ security category and also shall consider only in relation to official cars of VIPs/VVIPs, depending upon the category of security that such person has been awarded by the competent authority.
  - The Screening Committee shall meet twice in a year and its recommendation shall be referred to the State Level Committee for final disposal.
  - Any other aspect that the Screening Committee may think it just and proper to delve upon.

3. Terms of Reference of the State Level Committee:
  - i. The State Level Committee shall meet twice in a year and shall consider the recommendation of the Screening Committee and take appropriate decision regarding the issuance of exemption certificates in accordance with law and upon due application of mind with the approval of the competent authority.
  - ii. The State Level Committee shall also have power to review the exemption certificates as and when require, based on latest findings of the person concerned who have been exempted.
  - iii. Any other function, as may be entrusted by the State Government in connection with using of tinted glass/black films on safety glass of vehicles from time to time.
4. Further, the Director General of Police, Manipur shall issue necessary instructions to remove all tinted glass/black films from the offending vehicles and shall also challan such vehicles for violating Rules 92 and 100 of the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989.
5. This issues with the approval of the competent authority.
