ORDERS

Imphal, the 5th July, 2012

No. CHA/3/85-(Pt. 1).— Whereas, Manamjang UJB School was shifted to Siloi village under the Saitu-Gamphajol Sub-Division, Kangpokpi in the year 2002 vide Govt. Order No. CHA/3/85-(Pt. 1) dated 01-07-2002.

2. Whereas, consequent upon shifting of Manamjang UJB School to Siloi village, Shri Letthang Kipgen, Chief of Manamjang village Sadar Hills Kangpokpi, Manipur submitted a representation No. Nil dated 06-10-2006 addressed to the then former Hon'ble Minister (TD & Hills), Manipur requesting for re-installation of Manamjang UJB School. In this regard concerned area Deputy Inspector of School carried out a spot enquiry on 17-12-2006 and recommended for re-shifting/restoring Manamjang UJB School from Siloi Village to Manamjang village which was the original village where the said School was established.

3. Whereas, Chief Executive Officers, Sadar Hills Autonomous District Council, Kangpokpi stated vide his letter No. 3/67/SH-ADC/934/488 dated 19-12-2006 that the Manamjang UJB School has been functioning since 1970 to 2001 at Manamjang village, till it was shifted to Siloi village under the Saitu-Gamphajol Sub-Division, Kangpokpi in the year 2002 vide Govt. Order No. CHA/3/85-(Pt. 1) dated 01-07-2002.

4. Whereas, Shri Roingam Thanga, Member of District Council under the Sadar Hills Autonomous District Council 15-Bungte Chiru Constituency has submitted a D.O. letter No. Nil dated 11-05-2012 to the Joint Secretary (Tribal Affairs & Hills) Department, Govt. of Manipur requesting for restoration of Manamjang UJB School from Siloi village under the Saitu-Gamphajol Sub-Division, under SH-Autonomous District Council, Kangpokpi.

5. Therefore, the Governor of Manipur is pleased to order that the Manamjang UJB School which was originally established at Manamjang village will now be shifted/transferred from Siloi village with all the assets and liabilities/staff of the School to Manamjang the original village where the School was established first starting from the next academic session, 2013.
