NOTIFICATION

Imphal, the 30th November, 2013

No. 9/69/2011-CHA: Whereas, Hills Department, Government of Manipur brought out an official Notification No. 9/10/2004-CHA dated 16-08-2004 amalgamating the two villages of Lamlai Khullen and Lamlai Khunou into one village called Ramrei Village.

- 2. Whereas, the Autonomous District Council, Ukhrul in its sitting of the House held on 10-10- 2013 resolved and recommended vide letter No.1/30/Council-Meet/ADC-UKL/2010 dated 06-11-2013 for cancellation of the said Government Notification and for separation of the existing Ramrei Village into two separate villages viz, Lamlai Khullen and Lamlai Khunou as it was prior to the Official Notification.
- 3. Whereas, the Deputy Commissioner, Ukhrul vide his letter No.10/19/2011-Rev(Ukl) dated 11-03-2013 recommended for bifurcation of Ramrei Village and thereby cancelling the Official Notification No. 9/10/2004-CHA dated 16-08-2004.
- 4. And whereas, the Irrigation & Flood Control Department, Government of Manipur also recommended vide their letter No. CE/IFC/11-294/2013 dated 08-08-2013 and No.21/5/2013-IFC dated 27-08-2013 that bifurcation of Ramrei Village into two separate village i.e. Lamlai Khullen and Lamlai Khunou will be more convenient for implementing various programmes under Rehabilitation and Resettlement Packages of Thoubal Multipupose Project.
- 5. Now, therefore, the Governor of Manipur is pleased to order that the existing Ramrei Village, Phungyar Sub-Division under Ukhrul District shall be segregated into two villages viz, (i) Lamlai Khullen Village and Lamlai Khunou Village for all administrative purposes in the public interest.

This Notification shall be effective with effect from the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.
