**THE MANIPUR APPROPRIATION (No. 4) Bill, 2013
(As introduced in the Manipur Legislative Assembly)**

**A
BILL**

to provide for the authorization of appropriation moneys out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Manipur to meet the amounts spent on certain services during the financial year ended on the 31st day of March, 2008 in excess of the amounts as granted for those services and for that year.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Manipur in the Sixty fourth year of the Republic of India as follows:-

1. This Act may be called the Manipur appropriation (No. 4) Act, 2013.

Short Title

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Manipur, the sums specified in column 3 of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of eightyone crores fiftynine lakhs thirtythree thousand five hundred and fiftynine rupees shall be deemed to have been authorized to be paid and applied to meet the amount spent for defraying the charges in respect of the services specified in column 2 of the Schedule during the financial year ended on the 31st day of March, 2008 in excess of the amounts granted for those services and for that year.

Issue of Rupees 81,59,33,559/- from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Manipur to meet certain excess expenditure for the financial year ended on the 31st March 2008.

3. The sums deemed to have been authorized to be paid and applied from and out of the consolidated Fund of the State of Manipur under this Act shall be deemed to have been appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the financial year ended on the 31st day of March, 2008.

**MEMORANDUM SHOWING FINANCIAL IMPLICATION OF THE
MANIPUR APPROPRIATION (No. 4) BILL, 2013**

The Manipur Appropriation (No. 4) Bill, 2013 makes provisions for appropriation of a sum of Rs. 81,59,33,559/- (Rupees eightyone crores fiftynine lakhs thirtythree thousand five hundred and fiftynine only) from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Manipur to meet certain excess expenditure for the year ended on the 31st March, 2008. The various services and purposes for which the amount is sought to be appropriated have been shown in the Schedule to the Bill. The Public Accounts Committee has, in their Thirty Seventh Report recommended regularization of the excess expenditure amounting to Rs. 81,59,33,559/-.
